The ASSC is committed to keeping children safe, respected, and supported in all our activities.

V DO:

- Treat all children with respect and fairness
- Listen to their views and take them seriously
- Use positive, encouraging language
- Ensure another adult is present when with children
- Seek parental consent before photos/videos
- · Report any concerns immediately

O DO NOT:

- Engage in any form of abuse, neglect, or exploitation
- Be alone with a child in a private/isolated space
- Initiate physical contact unless for safety or instruction with consent
- Use inappropriate language, gestures, or jokes
- Communicate privately online without parental knowledge

REMEMBER:

Child safety is everyone's responsibility. If in doubt — speak up.

CHILD SAFETY REPORTING FLOW

- You see, hear, or suspect abuse/harm
- Ensure the child is safe from immediate danger
 Call 000 if urgent
- Report immediately to:

 A Child Safety Officer
 - Relevant state/territory child protection service
- Document what you saw/heard

 Use exact words if the child disclosed
 - Follow up
 - Support the childMaintain confidentiality
 - Cooperate with authorities
